Life Group Questions to consider:

- 1. What are your closest relationships? How have you seen them influence your values, your views, and your voice?
- 2. In Exodus 34:1-9, God proclaims His glory to Moses by describing Himself, and Moses worships God. How do each of these attributes of God drive you to worship Him? Is it harder to worship Him for some of these characteristics than for others?
- 3. Exodus 34:10-17 shows God renewing His covenant relationship with Israel, focusing on exclusivity. In what ways is your worship of God exclusive? What else competes with God to receive the worship only He deserves?
- 4. Then in Exodus 34:18-28 God calls Israel to remember and celebrate God's faithfulness in redeeming, providing, and protecting. How do you regularly celebrate the faithfulness He shows to you? When have you experienced His redemption, provision, and protection?
- 5. Moses' face shines in Exodus 34:29-35 because of his speaking with God. How evident is God's glory in your life because of your time with Him? In other words, how "shiny" are you? What's the difference in 2 Corinthians 3:15-18 between "shining" in the old covenant of Moses and the new covenant in Christ?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
