RESCUE - REVELATION - RELATIONSHIP | 9.10.2023

Life Group Questions to consider:

1. Where have you seen the pattern of needing rescue leading to new revelation leading to new relationship? Where is it difficult for you to admit that you need God to rescue you, reveal truth, and create relationship?
2. In Exodus 35:1-9, God reiterates the command to remember the sabbath day before the people begin work on the tabernacle. How should your life incorporate resting in God?
3. Exodus 35:20-29 shows God stirring the hearts and moving the spirits of His people to contribute to the cause of building the tabernacle. How is God calling you to trust Him and participate in His work?
4. We see extravagant giving from the Israelite people in Exodus 36:1-7, so much that the people must be restrained from giving more. How much do you contribute to the work of the Lord? How much should you give?
5. In Exodus 37:1-9 and 25-29, the ark of the covenant and the altar of incense are constructed. Why does God instruct the Israelites to build these items? How do these items and the overall structure of the tabernacle display God constructing relationship with His people?

PRAYER:

For each person in your group to know which next step God is calling them to. Pray that they will have clear opportunities to see God work in their lives.

Pray that the group would surround the collective next steps and help encourage as they are taken.

Pray for interactions with people far from God and for the group to be able to step into those conversations.
