

Pee Wee Valve and Pee Wee Valve Fork

PA0001 & PA0009



Instructions for use

NOTE: The Pee Wee Valve Fork, part number PA0009 is only for use when installing them original style Pee Wee Valve, part number PA0001. It is **NOT** for use with the Pee Wee Valve SI, part number PA-PWSI.

Installation into Thermoplastic Sockets:

NOTE: For proper installation, of the Pee Wee Valve (part # PA0001) into thermoplastic sockets, the "Fork" should be used.

- 1. Drill an 1/8-inch hole in cast at desired location
- Recess cast model slightly to permit flush mounting of the "Fork"
- 3. Place valve onto "Fork." Prongs on the Fork fit snugly into slots under valve
- 4. Lightly coat valve housing with 732 Dow Corning Silicone adhesive
- 5. Place protective cap bushing over valve stem
- 6. Blister-mold thermoplastic socket
- 7. Using heavy thread, tighten around valve body UNDER black "o"-ring
- 8. Tighten string around upper housing slot, just under the stem/cap
- 9. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN as threads may cut through plastic.
- 10. Remove thread, cool plastic, and sand top of valve stem/cap
- 11. Pry out cap and cut excess plastic away with sharp knife.

NOTE: NOT RECOMMENDED FOR LAMINATED SOCKETS. For Laminated Sockets, Use the Pee Wee SI Valve, Part Number: PA-PWSI
