Immediate Care

Go to Immediate Care for minor illnesses and injuries that need attention, but your primary care provider is not available.

- Allergies & asthma (mild)
- Colds, cough & flu
- Cuts & scrapes
- Diarrhea, nausea & vomiting
- Ear infections
- Insect bites & stings
- Rashes & skin irritations
- School/sports physicals
- Sore throats
- Sprains & strains
- Urinary tract infections



Emergency Care

Go to the Emergency Department for serious and/or life-threatening conditions.

- Broken bones
- Burns (severe)
- Chest pain or pressure
- Dehydration with prolonged diarrhea and/or vomiting
- Difficulty breathing
- Loss of consciousness
- Severe headache or head injuries
- Severe stomach pain
- Slurred speech
- Sudden numbness or weakness
- Uncontrolled bleeding
