In partnership with the Hydropower Foundation, the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL), will present U.S. workforce trends and the broader work produced through the science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) Workforce Development project funded by the DOE's Water Power Technologies Office. The workshop will also engage participants to identify common international challenges, trends and strategies to address hydropower industry workforce issues, with a goal of identifying best practices to strengthen the global hydropower industry.
