- Demonstrated understanding of historic trauma and the impact of colonization on Indigenous people.

- Understanding of the operations of service systems within the housing sector, Alberta Works and Income Supports, Justice and Community Services is an asset.
- Proficient working knowledge of database and information technology.
- Excellent interpersonal relations, conflict resolution, leadership and time management.
- Ability to seek out and build relationships with individuals, families, team members and community partners.
- Knowledge and experience utilizing motivational interviews and ability to net work with a range of partners and organizations.
