**3's Developmental Skills:** Learning activities include independent and group projects, use of manipulatives, games, crafts, independent and group play, songs, and open ended projects. **Social/emotional:** knowledge of self and curiosity in surroundings; self-help skills and appropriate inter and intra personal relationship skills.

**Language and emerging literacy:** continued enjoyment of stories and use and knowledge of books; continued and increased verbal communication to include identification of objects, oral directions and beginning print concepts.

**Physical:** proper development of fine and gross motor skills.

**Cognitive:** beginning number concepts, object characteristics, shape recognition, time and sequence concepts, dynamic world, creativity and memory.
