



How to Create a Rainbow Collage

Today you can be a rainbow in someone else's cloud by creating a rainbow collage.

Materials to create your Rainbow Collage:

- Collage materials - coloured or patterned paper, whatever you have at home! A piece of cardboard or paper - to be used as a backing sheet (approx A4 size or larger)
- Scissors
- Glue or sticky tape
- Pencils, textas
- Acrylic or watercolour paints (optional)
- Brushes (optional)

Instructions:

1. Collect bright and colourful pieces of paper from old books, magazines, wrapping paper etc and cut to different shapes and sizes (or you can rip up the paper if you don't have scissors). You might even like to paint your own favourite colours on some paper!
2. Draw the shape of a rainbow on your backing sheet of cardboard or paper.
3. Using your scissors, cut out the rainbow shape.
4. Choose pieces of your coloured or patterned paper and position them on the rainbow shape. Think about a colour theme - what colours impact your mood and make you feel calm or happy? Have a play around - it's ok to change your mind!
5. When you are happy with your design, use glue or sticky tape to attach your pieces of paper to your rainbow shape.
6. As a finishing touch, you might like to add some designs to your rainbow using your pencils, textas or paint. Whatever makes you happy!
