The "Tech-heavy NASDAQ" as it came to be known had turned in consecutive returns for the last 5 years of the '90s of 42%, 42%, 20%, 85%, and a whopping 101% to end the 20th century.

Alan Greenspan had been lambasted by Wall Street for his "irrational exuberance" quote. HOLY SPIRIT CHRISTMAS TREES






