WHAT TO KNOW

Before you can be accepted into our Apprenticeship Program, you must meet these requirements:

- You must be 18 years of age
- You must be physically fit to work in this industry and pass our entry assessment, also known as "Bootcamp."
- Bootcamp is a 5-day process

Day 1: Drug Test and Enrollment Paperwork

Day 2-4: Physical Agility Test

Day 5: Oral Interview

Call our office and request an application, apply online at www.LaborersTrainingSchool.com, under the 'Apprenticeship' tab or scan the QR code with your phone!

Wait to be invited to a boot camp or find a signatory employer that can sponsor you to bypass the waiting process.
