Before you can be accepted into our Apprenticeship Program, you must meet these requirements:

- You must be 18 years of age
- You must have a Valid Government Issued Photo I.D. and Social Security Number
- You must be physically fit to work in this industry and pass our entry assessment, also known as "Bootcamp."
- Bootcamp is a 5-day process

Day 1: Drug Test and Enrollment Paperwork

Day 2-4: Physical Agility Test

Day 5: Oral Interview

# R.S.I. RELATED SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION

For each period, you must complete your Related Supplemental Instruction (R.S.I.) hours in the classroom covering Certification Courses, Industry Courses, Environmental Courses, Endorsement Courses and a special 8 hour VOICE class.
