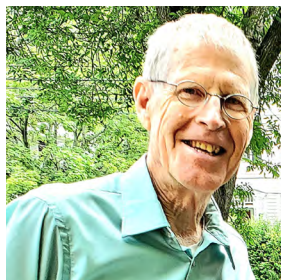


Gration Perera

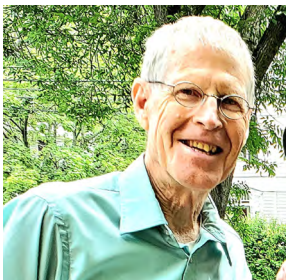

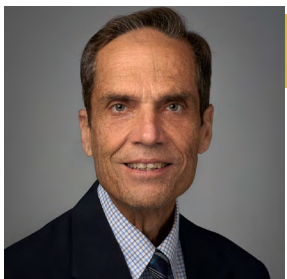

Trees of Righteousness: God's Plan for Dealing with Trauma, Grief, and Pain

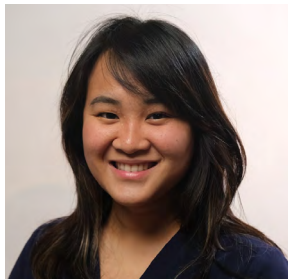

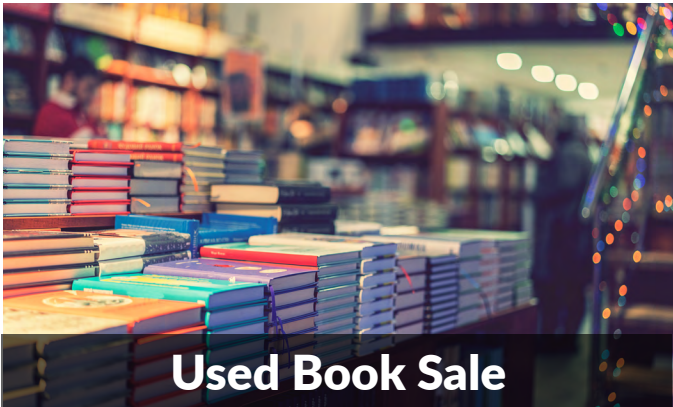
