Wasps tend to prefer conventional solutions to innovative ones. They tend to be chaotic and unstructured. #### Innovation focal points

#### **CONSERVATIVE**

 Do not try to cling to conventional solutions. Consider innovative alternatives

Ask yourself what you would change about an idea so that you would like it.

#### NONCHALANCE

O Don't be satisfied with your work too quickly. Agree on deadlines with others. Divide tasks into sub-goals with their own deadlines, which you complete separately.

O Provide enough moments where you are accountable to others.

Explain to others what you have done and why. Let them give feedback, ask questions and suggest improvements.

#### **DOMINANT**

In discussions, do not dismiss other opinions and really listen to them. VAsk others for individual preparation. Ask others for their opinion.

#### STRESS-SENSITIVE

② Do not try to avoid discussion and do not take feedback too personally. Think why stress is not necessary. Seek help from colleagues in case of stress. Anticipate tense moments.

#### DOMINANT

 Is assertive. Remains steadfast when ideas are implemented.

## Innovation roles for wasps
