



# 1. Project Background

The Wairarapa Combined District Plan (the District Plan) is now over ten years old and is due for review.

District Plans must be reviewed and updated every 10 years. The review of the District Plan is an opportunity to influence how land use and subdivision is managed in the districts.

The three Wairarapa District Councils have resolved to continue having a Combined District Plan for all three districts, and to jointly review the operative Combined District Plan.

## 2. Joint Committee July Workshop (2)

The Joint Committee met on 4 August 2022 where it received an update on the legislative provisions relating to its continuation through the upcoming election period.

Formal notification and engagement on the Proposed District Plan will take place in mid-2023.
