


This film captured and elevated the voices of our diverse community members and was the first step in highlighting the historical significance of our local Aboriginal community here on the Central Coast.

We currently mentor 23 Aboriginal students in School-Based Traineeships and have expanded in 2024 to offer Nursing, Allied Health, Pharmacy, Business Administration and Hospitality. Contact us if you are keen!

Make Tomorrow in Manufacturing

We were successful in our bid to operate an ISEP (Indigenous Skills and Employment Program) project funded by the Australia Government. Commencing in 2024, we open places in Manufacturing and Related Industries for entry-level training, work experience and paid work for 15-30-year-old Aboriginal people including school students. Contact us to find out more!

We already mentor young people into manufacturing, like Mia who is an Apprentice at the Vanhomes factory in Berkley Vale. Our staff member Alan O'Brien is the Mentor for Mia, her family and the employer to help things run smoothly.


Our much-anticipated annual members' Christmas party will take place on Saturday 16th December at the Central Coast Regional Sporting & Recreation Centre in Tuggerah.
