We do this by providing opportunities to:

GATHER for Life-Changing Worship

Kids have the opportunity to GATHER together every Sunday for age-appropriate, God-honoring worship. Xtreme Team kids get to help lead and support worship experiences.

GROW through Life-Changing Truth

Kids have a chance to GROW with other Christ followers as they learn truth from the Bible on Sunday mornings and in Xtreme Team on Wednesday nights.

GO in Life- Changing Mission

Kid's Life integrates opportunities for Kids to prepare to GO and minister to others as part of God's Life-Changing Mission. Kids are provided opportunities to learn how they can use their unique, God-given gifts and abilities to serve God in Xtreme Team. In other programming, kids have opportunities to be involved in projects that assist in reaching local and global communities with the Good News of Jesus Christ.

In XT, kids get to LEARN, LEAD and SERVE.

- -LEARN what God has to say.
 - Large Group Teaching (topics include loving others, serving, leading, our unique SHAPE, leadership lessons from Nehemiah, Xtreme Questions about life, etc.)
 - Small Group Interaction (1:6 ratio of adults to students focusing on practical life application of teaching)
- -LEAD others and grow in leadership skills
 - Team Building activities each week
 - Assessment tools (Spiritual Gift & Personality)
 - Opportunities to lead groups
- -SERVE others via hands-on experiences
 - Special teams (45 minutes of each night)
 - Outreach projects to community, opportunities to serve in church ministries (outside of Wed nights).

We will count it as a win if a student leaves Xtreme Team knowing:

- God created me uniquely
- Jesus wants me to be a good example
- Holy Spirit has given me gifts to serve others

We hope that all 5th graders and leaders become more like Jesus through their time in Xtreme Team!

Expectations

Parents/Guardians

- Bring kids on time (We start right at 6:30)
- Bring kids every week. This ministry is unique and builds upon itself all year long. If your child will be missing often, then XT may not be the best fit.
- We require all kids to be signed up before attending; therefore, we do not allow visitors in Xtreme Team unless they are committing to attend.
- Be sure kids bring Bible each week.
- Look for info about our parenting class that gives you resources for parenting your 5th grader as they move into middle school.
- Bring snacks/drinks for parties (Christmas, End-of-Year)
- Consider serving as an Xtreme Team Leader either all year as a Small Group Leader or Special Team leader.

Kids

- Attend Xtreme Team every week and be on time.
- Only bring visitors if they are planning to register and attend regularly.
- Bring Bible each week and keep binder in order.
- Check in each week
- (If possible) Serve on Sunday mornings if Special Team requires it.
- Keep phones off and in pocket/bag unless given permission by leader.
