

New Zealand – The Transport Accident Investigation
 Commission (TAIC) has released a <u>safety</u>
 <u>investigation report</u> into the serious injury of a crew
 member on board the 'Moana Chief' as it was leaving
 the Port of Auckland. As the telescopic
 accommodation ladder was being retrieved, a crew
 member's lower leg became trapped between the
 fixed upper ladder and the moving lower ladder,
 resulting in serious injury to their leg.

Regulations Recently Entered into Force

IMO and ILO regulations that have entered into force or been amended recently include:

- Amendments to the 2011 ESP Code as amended by resolution MSC.461(101) – Minimum requirements for thickness measurements at renewal surveys of double-hull oil tankers – effective 1 January 2023
- Amendments to the STCW Convention 1978 New definition for "high-voltage" – effective 1 January 2023
- Amendments to Part A of the STCW Code Inclusion of electro-technical officers in the definition of "operational level" – effective 1 January 2023
- Amendment to the AFS Convention Control of AFS containing Cybutryne – effective 1 January 2023
