## **AHCS Photo Competition – Terms & Conditions**

In participating in the AHCS Photo competition organised by the Australian Highland Cattle Society Inc. entrants must agree to the following terms and conditions:

- This competition opens when announced to members and the closing date for receipt of entries is stated on the entry form. By discretion, the AHCS may allow extension past this closing date.
- This competition is only open to current financial and honorary AHCS members.
- Entry into the AHCS Photo competition is free and will include automatic entry, subject to images meeting minimum criteria, into two (2) competition sections as follows:

### **General Photo section –**

- Winning photos will be selected for publication at the Society's discretion in any of the AHCS Publications produced after the closing date of this competition, including, but not limited to, the AHCS Highland Fling newsletter, the AHCS website, Facebook page and Facebook group, and any future promotional material produced by the AHCS.
- Entrants will not be advised if and when their winning photos have been selected and there is no defined date by which photos entered in this section will be chosen for publication.

### **Calendar section –**

Winning entrants will receive:

- one or more of their submitted photos published on a month of the AHCS Calendar; and
- their Fold name (if the entrant has one) or membership name, property, town and state printed on a month of the AHCS Calendar along with their published photo(s).

Photographs entered must present as the main feature at least one Highland cattle animal or part of a Highland cattle animal. The Highland cattle featured in the photographs submitted must belong to, or have belonged to, the entrant at the time the photo was taken. Photographs may also include motives of landscape, buildings, people or other animals.

- Photographs entered may be taken on any date prior to the closing date of the competition, so long as all other conditions are met. Entrants may submit photographs that have previously been entered in an AHCS Photo competition so long as these photos have not previously been published in the AHCS Calendar.
- The AHCS reserves the right to publish photos entered in previous years' competitions in the AHCS Calendar if there are insufficient eligible photos meeting the minimum criteria submitted in this competition.

## **AHCS Photo Competition – Terms & Conditions**

- Entries should be supplied as a high-quality digital image (preferably 300dpi) with a preferred size of 297mm wide x 210mm high. Acceptable digital file formats are jpg, jpeg, tif or tiff, and images of file formats different from these will not be eligible for entry into the competition. Photographs of image resolution and dimensions less or different from the preferred criteria may be entered in the General Photo section of the competition, but photographs not meeting the minimum specification of 300dpi and deviating too far from the preferred image size may be excluded from the Calendar section of the competition.
- Entrants may submit from one (1) up to three (3) photographs in their submission.
- All photographs must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any third party. In the photographs entered the entrant must be the sole owner of copyright and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the photograph. In the case of children under 16 being featured, permission of guardian must be obtained. In addition, entrants must not have breached any laws when taking the entry photographs.
- Photographs must be free of any signature or watermark or any other identifying marks.
- Photographs are not to be manipulated, however, digital enhancements such as removed spots or changed brightness and contrast of picture are allowed. The AHCS reserves the right to exclude any image from the competition that it believes may have been excessively treated so as to alter its authenticity.
- Entrants must submit their entries via the dedicated AHCS Photo Competition web form, on which entrants must supply their name, membership and contact details and any other mandatory fields included on the entry form. The entrant acknowledges that the entrant's name, Fold or property name, property town, State and their Fold profile, either in whole or in part and as edited by the AHCS Publishing team, may be published with any of their photos selected for publication.

Entrant details other than those explicitly specified will remain confidential.
