Summary: Shining Rock Classical Academy will create a welcoming culture for parents and community.

Baseline: In the first year, we provided one day per semester for student led conferences. In addition, we hosted Open House for all families to meet faculty members. Through fieldwork and charitable contributions, we are laying the foundation for strong community relationships.

Measurable Objective: 65% of Shining Rock families will participate in various volunteer/outreach opportunities within the school community. 65% of Shining Rock families will participate in at least one student led conference per year.

Goal Four: School administration and Board of Directors in cooperation with other stakeholders, will facilitate the acquisition of high-quality technology and training.

Summary: Administration and the Board of Directors will provide teachers and students increased access and capacity to technology to enhance 21st Century teaching and learning.

Baseline: Current levels of technology in place as of February, 2019, including one-to-one Chromebook, each classroom has a Mimio projector and document scanner, K-3 teachers have iPads. Entire school operates off of a Google Chrome platform.

Measurable Objective: A minimum of two percent of the school's annual budget will be dedicated to acquiring, upgrading and replacing technology, and providing staff technology training.
