Job Description

You would be taking on the role of Acting ASM to support us with get-ins and get-outs whilst multi-rolling with various minor characters and supporting as potential understudy to a major character should this be required at any point.

You will be expected to be touring with shows across the UK as part of the Julius Caesar UK Tour in 2024 (please see schedule provided). There will also be an element of desk work to maintain whilst supporting the Touring Company Stage Manager and the Touring Production Manager.

Responsibilities:

- An actor in your own right who is comfortable with managing various tasks alongside your acting ability.
- Facilitate communication and coordination among all theatre departments, consolidating information.
- Communicating with all venue tech departments to ensure adequate preparation for our arrival both by the theatre and touring company.
- Supporting with planning of transfer of set/costumes throughout rehearsals and touring.
- Support the installation of sets, lighting, and sound at the designated locations during get-in and get-out periods.
- Make necessary adjustments to the set and props when/if required.
- Supporting the coordination with Lighting and Sound Technicians during rehearsals, providing cues and instructions.
- Assisting on risk assessments and staff wellbeing as necessary.
- Other preparations for tour as necessary.





Requirements and Skills:

- Full, clean, UK driver's licence
- Proven work experience as an actor.
- An interest, affinity, or experience in stage management
- Ability to work effectively under pressure
- Keen attention to detail

Desirable Skills:

- Proficiency in computer skills (particularly with QLab 5) and familiarity with current technology used in theatre production
- Understanding of Theatre Green Book principles and implementation of this into the work
- HGV Licence
- First Aid Training
- At least 2 credits from mid-large-scale touring or residency productions, either as an actor or in Stage Management
- OSHA or similar qualifications
- Skills in the trading field (building, carpentry, welding etc.)
- Skills within technical theatre departments transferable
