**Verification module**

You will be eligible for the Verification audit pathway if all of the selected registration groups in your application fall under the Verification category

**Certification pathway**

Higher risk, more complex services and supports

Providers implementing restrictive practices (Module 2A) are always included in the Certification audit pathway, regardless of the registration groups applied for.

Once you register with the NDIS Commission, the modules and method of assessment will be confirmed on an "Initial Scope of Audit" document generated by your application.
