We have a strong and capable finance team that supports the CEO, Board and Treasurer.

The initial appointment will be for a period of two years and we welcome applications from people of all orientations, backgrounds and abilities.

## **Selection Criteria:**

- High ethical standards and a willingness to commit to quality, equity and upholding the values, vision and mission of Biala Peninsula
- Accounting qualifications and experience
- Strong finance, risk management and/or business experience
- Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to undertake collaborative decision making
- Ability to support the development of the strategic plan
- Previous or current Board experience and understanding of non-profit, community organisations would be highly regarded

## **Commitment:**

Being the Treasurer of Biala Peninsula involves attendance at an evening Board Meeting once per month, a planning session each year and chairing our Finance and Risk Committee which meets 4-6 times per year. Meetings are held virtually via Zoom with the aim to be in person at our Mornington office twice per year.

Applicants will need to successfully complete a number of probity checks prior to becoming a Board Member which includes a Working with Children, NDIS Worker Screening and Police Check. Proof of three COVID vaccinations or a medical exemption are also required.
