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Founded in 2012, The Dave Krache Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that helps kids play the sports they love, even when their families aren't in the financial position to pay all of the sports fees.

The Foundation's purpose started as an attempt to fundraise for kids in need for baseball and softball recreational league fees and has evolved to other sports – basketball, football, and even cycling and lacrosse.

The focus is on metro Atlanta and kids have been helped in Cobb, Cherokee, Dekalb, Douglas, and Paulding counties.

By the end of 2021, The Dave Krache Foundation listed 975 children between the ages of 5 and 17 who have benefited from the Foundation's efforts, with word of the Foundation and its purpose spreading.

Sports are an important part of kids' lives and health. They can help teach hand-eye coordination and balance, as well as help grow self-esteem. They teach the value of perseverance and the importance of practice. The value of healthy competition can do wonders for a kid's confidence and maturity.

Our application process is simple:

A parent or guardian of the child who wishes to play fills out a form online on our website. Once that is submitted, DKF Staff requests the coach complete a verification form and answer some questions about the league or team.
