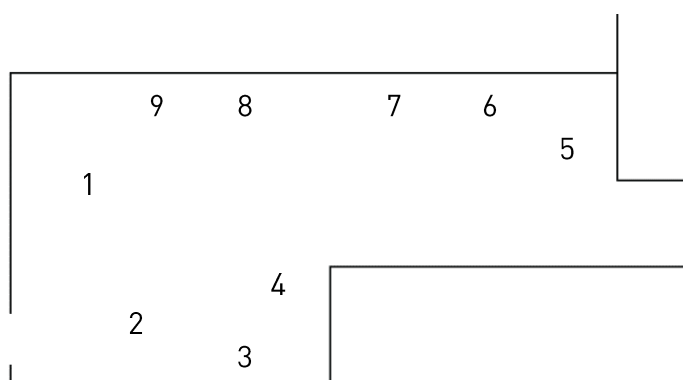


SUBURBAN TURRETS
