



**Dr. Jon Anderson** is Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs at Southern Utah University (SUU), a regional institution with more than 15,000 students. He oversees a budget of \$85 million in a division with nearly 550 full-time faculty/staff and more than 400 adjunct instructors, and led development of SUU's latest strategic plan. During Anderson's tenure, Southern Utah has increased its headcount, reorganized its college/school structure, launched its first doctoral program, and added in-person and online degrees and majors aligned with industry needs.

Prior to joining SUU, Anderson was Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs at Middle Georgia State University, which has five physical campuses and an online division. He also has held administrative positions at the University of West Georgia, where he was Deputy Provost and Associate Vice President, and at the University of Kentucky.

Anderson earned a Ph.D. in Business Administration: Management from the University of Kentucky; an M.Ed. in Business Education from the (State) University of West Georgia; a B.S. in Sociology from Utah State University; and an A.A.S. in General Studies: Health and Education from Ricks College (Idaho).
