

Dr. Philip Acree Cavalier is Provost and Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs at the University of Tennessee at Martin (UTM), where he served as Interim Chancellor from March through August 2023. UTM is a primary regional university in the University of Tennessee System with about 6,800 students; it includes a main campus, five regional centers, and an online division.

At UTM, Cavalier is leading a partnership and grant program with Ford Motor Company. He also chaired the university's strategic planning committee and led a Foundations of Excellence self-study project focused on the first-year student experience. During his tenure, UTM has increased its graduate

enrollment, added new graduate and undergraduate programs, and developed study-abroad programs for students.

Prior to joining UTM, Cavalier was Provost and Vice President of Academic Services at Lyon College (Ark.), Provost and Dean of the College at Eureka College (Ill.), and Dean of General Education at Catawba College (N.C.). He earned a Ph.D. in English from the State University of New York at Buffalo; an M.A. in English at Northeastern University; and a B.A. in Economics at Swarthmore College (Pa.).
