<u>UPDATES & DISCUSSION ITEMS</u>

Yagers Spring Development

Mayor Dofflemyer thanked everyone for attending this meeting to discuss the status of the Greenway extension to Yagers Spring.

Mr. Beyer provided a history on the acquisition of the Yagers Property by the Town.

Mr. Graves provided a history of the property and its significance to the establishment of Luray as a Town due to the development of the furnace by the Ruffner family. He also discussed the property use from the early/mid 1700's through the end of the 1800's.

Mr. Racey provided an overview of the plan development status for the Greenway extension. He pointed out that part of the project will be the rehabilitation or stabilization of the dam for the spring. Mr. Racey discussed the components of the final design proposal that includes environmental permitting and a Phase I Cultural Resources evaluation. These components should be the first completed. Following these steps, the Final Design will include geotechnical investigations, structural engineering, and finalized floodplain determination. An updated proposal outlining this work will be provided to the Town and Foundation for consideration.

Mr. Smith discussed his concerns about a historic document showing a spring house with Mr. Racey.

Mr. Dofflemyer invited attendees to walk the grounds to inspect the dam and tour the Cafeteria House.
