Various prayer-focused resources will be available week by week, and month by month, through the year of Prayer:

- Each week a **two-page reflection**, taken from the writings and preaching of Pope Francis, and focused on the coming Sunday's Gospel, will be circulated in the Wednesday Roundup.
- Each week a **two-line extract** from the above-mentioned reflection will be included in the Newsletter page of the Wednesday Roundup, for possible inclusion (via *cut and paste*) in parish newsletters and on parish websites.
- Each week a **suggested intercession** will be included in the Newsletter page of the Wednesday Roundup, for possible using during Sunday Mass.
- Each month a one-side-of-A4 sheet will be produced reflecting on the **theme of the month**, as given overleaf. This will be photocopyable for distribution to parishioners, or for inclusion on parish websites, noticeboards, circulation in schools, etc, and provided through the Wednesday Roundup on the penultimate Wednesday of the preceding month.
- Each season a simplified version of **Morning and Evening Prayer** will be produced, one-side-of-A4 for each, for distribution to parishioners, in schools, etc, and for use at parish meetings, etc the aim being to help parishioners to actually pray, rather than simply always talking about praying and never doing it!
- The Walk with Me booklet for Lent 2024 will focus on prayer it would be good to address why this isn't being more widely taken-up across the diocese, and see if any stumbling blocks to use can be removed.
- The Bishops' Conference is producing resources based around the **Our Father** for use in parishes, small groups, and solo-use, during Lent 2024. It's anticipated that this will be available in January.
- Suitable **on-line resources**, apps, etc will be sourced and promoted throughout the year. The aim will be not to launch everything all at once at the start, but to keep bringing something new to the theme as the year unfolds.
- The Mark 10 Mission, the Wednesday Word, and other school-age-appropriate resources will be circulated to parishes, for possible use with Children's Liturgy groups, children not in Catholic schools, etc.
