

Biathlon Canada Names Tour 1 Teams for the IBU Circuit

Biathlon Canada is proud to announce a team of 20 athletes from five different Provinces and Territories who will represent Canada on the World Cup, IBU Cup and Junior Cup circuits for the first Trimester of the season.

The World Cup Season opener starts November 25 in Sweden followed by the IBU Cup on November 30 in Finland. The Junior tour starts a few weeks later on December 9 in Slovenia.

The flow for the first Trimester looks a little different than in previous years. Emily Dickson, Benita Peiffer, Trevor Kiers, and Zach Connelly will join the World Cup Team for the first World Cup in Sweden. They will then transfer to the IBU Cup for the remaining competitions of the IBU Cup.
