 - 11pm: Joya no Kane (ringing of the bell 108 times in the main hall, ending just after midnight.)
 - 12:05am: New Year's Eve ceremony in the main hall.

- 11:00am: Goma (fire ritual) will be conducted in the practice hall. You may write out prayer boards with your New Year wishes, to be burned in the fire.

PLEASE PARK in the gravel visitor's lot at the address **S470 Hirst Road, Reedsburg WI** (do NOT park on the side of the road, as you will be ticketed and towed by the county). From there, follow the trail in the rear of the lot through the forest to our monastery, about a five minute walk. Watch your step, as it can be slippery if there is rain or snow.
