

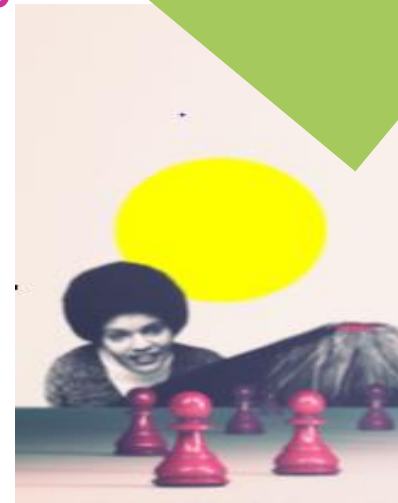

Evolution of public policies of equality in Euskadi

- Exigencies of the feminist movement of the 80s
- Creation of the Basque Institute of Women- Emakunde in 1988
- Positive action plans for women.
- Integration of gender perspective/transversality
- Law 4/2005 for equality. Key factors:
 - People
 - Budgets
 - Competencies
 - Instruments



Instruments

- Analysis of the regulations through gender impact reports,
- Gender budgets,
- Equality clauses in contracts and subsidies,
- Information systems disaggregated by sex- gender,
- Formative itineraries
