WE ARE CURRENTLY IN THE SEASON OF EASTERTIDE: We are currently in the season of Eastertide through May 12th. Service times are: 7:30 am, 9:00 am, 11:15 am and 5:00 pm.

THE NAVE IS EQUIPPED WITH A T-COIL SYSTEM to enhance the ability of those with hearing aids. Those with hearing aids should sit in the lower middle section of the nave as close to the center aisle as possible. To determine if your hearing aid is T-Coil-compatible, check with your audiologist.

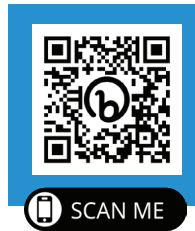
