



# WEDDING PARTY

How many will we have in our wedding party? Who do you want on your side? Who will pay for the wedding party? (i.e. will the groomsmen pay for their own suits, etc) What will happen during our bachelor/bachelorette parties? Who will hold the rings during the ceremony? [If you have siblings] Do you expect to have my brother/sister on your side? What will the role of the best man be? What will the role of the maid/matron of honor be? How much will we spend on our wedding party? (e.g. Bachelor/bachelorette parties, gifts, etc) FOOD & DRINK Will there be alcohol? Will we have a full dinner, snacks, something else? No food at all? Why type of food to we want? What type of drinks do we want? Will we cater the food or have a family member make it? How much should we spend on food? Will we have lunch/snacks for the bridal party? Will we take a to-go dinner?

# WEDDING CEREMONY

Will we do a first look? Or will we see each other for the first time as we walk down the aisle? Can guests have their cell phones out during the ceremony for pictures? What time will the wedding start? Will we write our own vows? Will our families sit together or apart? (i.e. a his and her side) Who will walk down the aisle? (i.e. grandparents, parents, bridal party, etc) Who will walk each of us down the aisle? (*Note: It's typically customary for* the bride's father or step-father to walk her down the aisle. There's no clear "tradition" for the groom. We opted to have the groom walk his mother down the aisle and to her seat as his father trailed behind). Who will be the ring bearer/flower girl? Will we have one? Who will officiate the wedding? Are there any fun or non-traditional elements we want to include? (e.g.: communion, lighting candles, sand pouring, tying of a cord, family prayer, dance intro) Will we have ushers or allow guests to seat themselves? WEDDING RECEPTION Will we have a dance? Will we have assigned seating or can people sit where they want? Will we have a DJ? Will we have dessert? If so, what kind? Do you want to smash cake or eat it normally? Will we have time set aside for just us? Will we have speeches? If so, who will give them?

What time will we leave for the night? How should we leave for the night? (e.g. just leave, sparklers, rice, confetti) Will we have a first dance? Will we have a mother/son dance? Will we have a father/daughter dance? Will we give guests take home goodies? AFTER THE WEDDING Who will write thank you notes? When will we write thank you notes? How will we open gifts?
