'Atlas'

H: 12-48" Zone: 3

An early and vigorous yielder.
Medium to large green spears
with slight purple tip.



'Purple Passion'

H: 36-48" W: 18-24" Zone: 3

Produces attractive purple spears
which have a mild, nutty flavour
and are reputedly sweeter than
most other asparagus varieties.



Armoracia rusticana

Horseradish

H: 45cm Zone: 5

Hardy plant whose roots can be
grated for use in horseradish
sauce.



Helianthus Tuberosus

Jerusalem Artichoke

H: 72-120" W: 36-60"

Zone: 3

Type of sunflower that has
knobby edible tubers which
are produced under ground. It
has an artichoke like taste.



Rheum Rhabarbarum

Rhubarb

H: 36-48" 90-120cm

Zone: 3 Large, heart-
shaped, crinkled leaves with red
stems. The stems are used like
fruit in pies and sauces.

nigrum 'Wellington'

Black Currant

'Wellington'

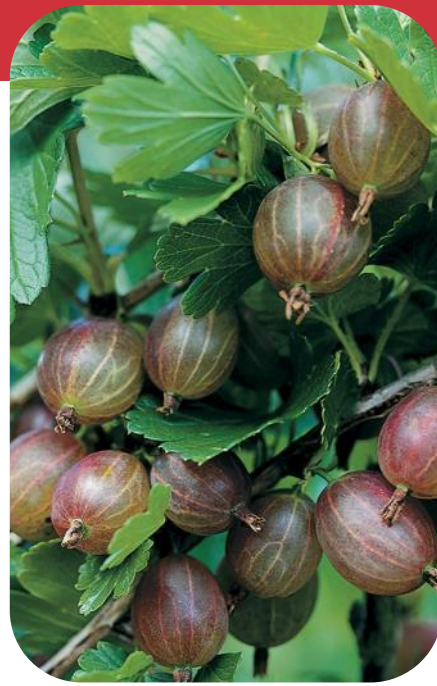
H: 36-48" 90-120cm Zone: 3a
Regarded as the most popular black currant variety. Has excellent sweet and juicy fruit. Best if planted with other currants.



nigrum 'Magnus'

Black Currant 'Magnus'

H: 36-48" 90-120cm Zone: 4a
Deep purple, juicy berries and large, soft green fragrant leaves. Best if planted with other currants.



hirtellum 'Pixwell'

Gooseberry 'Pixwell'

H: 36-48" 90-120cm Zone: 4
Dense, nearly thornless bush with glossy leaves. Strong producer of pinky-green berries that make good pies and jellies. Self-fertile.



Rubrum 'Red Lake'

Red Currant

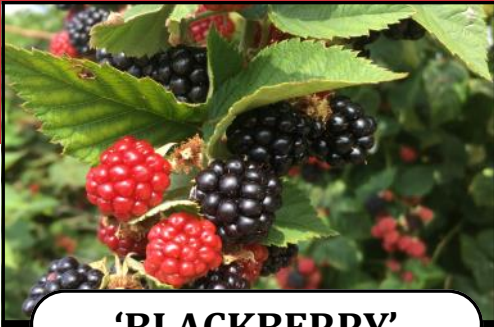
H: 36-60" 90-150cm Zone: 3
Compact, mounding, deciduous shrub. Clusters of greenish-yellow flowers bloom in spring. Flowers turn to clusters of bright red berries. Self-fertile.

Jostaberry

H: 36-60" 90-150cm Zone: 4a
Cross between a gooseberry and a black currant. Clusters of sweet, tangy, dark purple berries. Self-fertile.



'BLACKBERRY'

Fruticosus Chester

H: 36-60" 90-150cm Zone: 5
Semi-erect, thornless blackberry.
Clusters of pinkish-white flowers
turn into firm blackberries.



'BOYNE'

Raspberry x idaeus 'Boyne'

H: 48-74" 120-188cm Zone: 6a
Early season, self-fruitful shrub with
sweet, flavourful, deep red berries
in summer.



'FALL GOLD'

Raspberry idaeus 'Anne'

H: 36-48" 90-120cm Zone: 3
A rare, exciting self-fertile gold rasp-
berry that is deliciously sweet.
Produces two crops a season.



'HERITAGE RED'

Raspberry idaeus 'Heritage'

H: 48-60" 120-150cm Zone: 4
The classic Heritage is the best fall
crop selection. Produces berries in
the summer and the fall.



'JEWEL BLACK'

Raspberry idaeus 'Jewel'

H: 48-72" 120-180cm Zone: 3
The blue-black fruits are large and
sweet.



'ROYALTY PURPLE'

Raspberry idaeus 'Royalty'

H: 24-36" 60-90cm Zone: 4a
Produces large fruit with distinctive,
sweet flavour.



'TAYBERRY'

Tayberry

H: 96-120" 240-300cm Zone: 6a
Cross between a blackberry and a
raspberry.



'MARIONBERRY'

L. Subgenus Rubus

H: 60-72" 150-180cm Zone: 6
Sweet, tart berries with complex
flavour. Plant has a trailing growth
habit.



'BOYSENBERRY'

Boysenberry

H: 48-72" 120-180cm Zone: 5a
Unique fruit bush which is a cross
between the loganberry and the
blackberry plant.

STRAWBERRY



Veestar Strawberry

H: 10" 25cm Zone: 3

This variety produces an early yield of medium red berries with good flavour in late spring. June bearing variety.

Fragaria 'Veestar'



Everbearing Strawberry

H: 8-10" 20-25cm Zone: 4

Everbearing strawberry plants produce fruit throughout an entire growing season. Beginning in spring, with intermittent crops throughout the summer and early fall.

VACCINIUM-BLUBERRY

Blueberries require two different cultivars to fruit reliably. Need acidic soil to grow.



corymbosum 'Bluecrop'

'Bluecrop' Blueberry

H: 72-84" 180-210cm Zone: 5
Produces light blue berries which ripen in mid-season. Dark green leaves turn attractive shades of red in the fall.



'Blue Jay'

'Blue Jay' Blueberry

H: 84" 210cm Zone: 4a
Prized for its reliable yields of large tasty fruit in mid-summer. Berries have a sweet taste and juicy texture.



'Blue Ray'

'Blue Ray' Blueberry

H: 72-84" 180-210cm Zone: 5
Dainty, waxed, bell-shaped white flowers appear in May. Flowers are followed by medium sized blueberries that ripen in mid-season.



'Chandler'

'Chandler'

H: 59-78" 150-200cm Zone: 4
Flavourful fruit ripens mid to late season over a prolonged period, providing a harvest for up to six weeks. Upright, well branched form.



'Legacy'

'Legacy' Blueberry

H: 72" 180cm Zone: 5
Produces a heavy crop of medium to large berries in the late season. Foliage turns to crimson in the Fall.



'Northblue'

'Northblue' Blueberry

H: 36-48" 90-120cm Zone: 3a
Midseason producer of large, dark-blue blueberries. Green foliage turns to red in the fall.

VACCINIUM-BLUBERRY

Blueberries require two different cultivars to fruit reliably. Need acidic soil to grow.



'Spartan'

'Spartan' Blueberry

H: 36-48" 90-120cm Zone: 5

Attractive and tasty fruit that is often larger than a quarter in size. Tangy sweet flavour.

VITIS—GRAPES



'Baco Noir'

'Baco Noir' Grape

H: 2-4m as trained Zone: 4

Vigorous grower that produces tight cylindrical clusters of small red berries. Great for making juice.

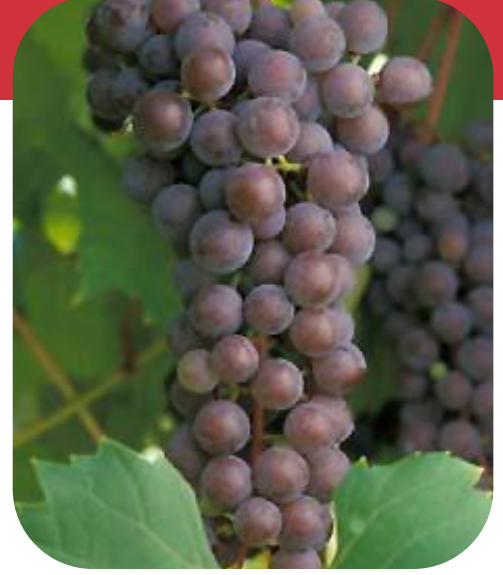


labrusca 'Concord'

'Concord' Grape

H: 2-4m as trained Zone: 5

Fragrant, greenish flowers in spring are followed by clusters of blue-black, seeded grapes. Best juicing grape.



'Frontenac'

'Frontenac' Grape

H: 96" W: 72" Zone: 4a

A newer wine grape which is becoming popular. Produces an abundance of large fruit in the fall. Excellent for red wine or juice.



'Himrod'

'Himrod' Grape

H: 2-4m as trained Zone: 5
Fragrant greenish-white flowers form into clusters of seedless white grapes. Good for fresh eating or drying as raisins. Seedless



'Seyval Blanc'

'Seyval Bank White

H: 2-4m as trained Zone: 4
Hybrid wine grape used to make white wine. Vines ripen early, are productive and suitable for fairly cool temperatures. Harvest in August.



'Vanessa'

'Vanessa' Grape

H: 2-4m as trained Zone: 4
Produces loose clusters of well filled firm oval medium sized seedless deep red grapes. Good for eating fresh or making preserves.
