Straight Ladders

Our ladders are ideal for accessing roof hatches, mezzanines, and maintenance catwalks where deck space is limited. All ladders are custom manufactured to meet your specifications and local code.

- Manufactured with 1-½ square tube vertical rails with ¾" #6 rebar rungs.
- Designed to meet OSHA regulations
- Manufactured with or without cage
- Available with painted or galvanized finish • 4" channel side frames
- Smaller footprint than ship's ladder

Ship's Ladders

Ship's ladders are more comfortable to climb than vertical rung ladders, particularly while carrying items. They are sloped at angles not less than 75 degrees from horizontal, and utilize flat-topped steps with anti-slip surfaces. Ship's ladders have a larger footprint than vertical ladders - available space must be considered.

- 75 degree minimum slope from horizontal
- Easier to climb than straight ladder
- 4" deep steps with 1" wide anti-skid strip
- 1-½ square tube handrails
- Designed to meet OSHA requirements for fixed ladders (reference OSHA Standard Number 1910.27)
- Available with painted or galvanized finish
