Job Purpose

Time will be allocated for you to undertake the necessary formal learning throughout the year.

- Following risk assessments, operating procedures and training given to adhere to best practice.
- Follow all IL policies and procedures.
- Take an active role in sessions with a view to leading them by yourself in the future.
- Maintain a professional relationship between client and instructor.

- Be physically fit and able to fulfil the role.
- Have a keen interest in the outdoors and adventurous activities.
- Be 18 years old or above before the apprenticeship starts.
- Be comfortable talking to new people from various backgrounds.
- Be punctual, reliable and adaptable.
- Hold a pass in English and Maths or equivalent (functional skills)
