#### Parsha tidbits from the Rabbi

The Jewish people fought two major wars when leaving Egypt: the war with Pharaoh; and the war with Amalek. About the war with Pharoah it says, "קַּחֶם לְּכֶם" - G-d Will fight for you." About the war with Amalek, however, it says "Go out, and fight Amalek." Since with Egypt, Pharaoh wanted them back as slaves and did not directly stop them from receiving the Torah, G-d said "I will fight him!" Amalek, however, wanted to stop the Jews from getting to Mount Sinai and ever receiving the Torah! Therefore, G-d instructed the Israelites to fight for what is eternally yours, the Torah and all its teachings. We learn from this that if a nation will try to eradicate us because we follow the Torah and its laws we must wipe them out. Amalek was not and is not interested in our Land or our material wealth. They wish to destroy us because of who we are and what our values are. For this, in our very days, we stand against this wicked terror once again. As in the Purim story, b'Ezrat Ha-Shem, we will stamp out Amalek.

# Parsha thought from Rabbi Arthur Kirsch

Sefer Vayikra starts with Hashem calling to Moshe. Why doesn't it state, "and Hashem spoke to Moshe saying," as usual? Rashi answers that it is a Loshon of "Chibe" (Love) for Moshe, so it says calling to Moshe. This is a lesson to all young Rabbis. You can have the greatest Talmid of all time, like Moshe Rabeinu, and the greatest teacher that has ever existed, like Hashem, but that is not enough! You need a love between the Rebbi and the talmid for true learning to exist.
