The information below outlines our plan and goals. I hope you will join us in supporting this exciting and critical endeavor.


LOOKING TOWARD THE NEXT HORIZON

At Marin Horizon, we constantly evolve to meet the ever-changing needs of our students and the ever-changing times we live in.

This means both preserving the best of our signature experience and exploring new ways in which to learn, support, challenge, and inspire.

Ensuring that we can meet the needs of future generations calls for renewed commitment and resources.





We are now launching our Next Horizon Campaign to fuel this vision for the future while deepening our dedication to our students' ability to grow and thrive in this unique environment.

Our campaign's key priorities:

- Further enhancing Marin Horizon's outdoor facilities to benefit both our students and the entire community.
- Strengthen our financial foundation through growing a more robust endowment. This will allow us to stand ready to respond rapidly, flexibly, and creatively to challenges ahead and have impact on our ability to retain and recruit the best educators.





Since 1977, Marin Horizon School has lived our commitment to educational rigor and student independence and creativity. Among our accomplishments:



Student Success

Marin Horizon students continually excel throughout the curriculum.

- A recent study of 5th to 7th grade outcomes among independent schools showed that 75 to 84 percent of our students were at or above the independent-school average in areas of reading comprehension, quantitative reasoning, and writing skills and concepts.
- After graduation from Marin Horizon, students take their place at some
 of the most prestigious and highly competitive public and independent
 high schools in the Bay Area.

Fostering Diversity, Equity, Inclusion

- Nurturing respect, awareness, and curiosity about one another and the world is woven into the fabric of the Marin Horizon School experience.
- Our founding and support for the Horizon Community School in Marin City provides an early childhood education program that advances educational equity and social justice.
- Scholarship support for families helps ensure that all students have the educational opportunities they deserve—29 percent of our students now receive this support.





Providing a Rich Experiential Education

- Marin Horizon has established a five-year experiential education priority, integrating the current curriculum with outdoor education, enhancing outdoor education trips, and expanding service-learning opportunities across all grades.
- These programs develop leadership and teamwork, promote problem-solving, and reinforce the importance of community and the environment.

Enhancing Learning Spaces

Generous support from the Marin Horizon School community has made possible:

 A new 4,000-square-foot building, completed in 2020, that houses state-of-the-art classrooms for kindergarten and first grade and a new light-filled, dedicated library.







EYES ON MARIN HORIZON'S BRIGHT FUTURE


Many hands and much effort were involved in planning the Next Horizon Campaign.

More than 100 members of the community, including current and former parents and donors, participated in our 2021 feasibility study that focused on the priorities outlined here.

- \$3 million to support a Board-designated endowment fund focused on faculty recruitment and retention.





Creating a Vibrant Outdoor Campus

As part of our commitment to experiential education and environmental stewardship, a priority was set within our 2016-2021 strategic plan, to enhance our outdoor space, the importance of which was reaffirmed during the pandemic. Now is the time to retire our aging (45-year-old) portable classrooms and make room for a more vibrant and expanded outdoor campus.

Our goal of \$3 million will allow us to expand and modernize our outdoor areas to provide greater opportunity for creative and physical play, as well as a gathering space for assemblies, outdoor classes, and events to welcome the community. It will afford ample opportunities for multiple grades to use the space simultaneously.



Investing in Our Future and Our Faculty

A strong endowment will ensure Marin Horizon School's success in the years to come, allowing us to respond to emerging needs, make critical investments, sustain us during uncertain times, and stabilize rising tuition costs.

A robust endowment:

- Ensures a healthy future while providing the flexibility to respond to market demands.
- Focuses on long-term growth, to generate income in perpetuity. Thus, gifts to endowment continue to give long after they are made. The pandemic has demonstrated the importance of sustainable financial resources beyond tuition and annual fundraising.

Currently, Marin Horizon's endowment of \$4 million ranks in the lower third of other Bay Area independent school endowments. The National Association of Independent Schools recommends an endowment of twice the annual budget. With a current annual budget of \$10 million, Marin Horizon's endowment falls significantly short of this benchmark.







Fostering Faculty Excellence

Our school is immensely proud of our 51 faculty members, who are extraordinary in their knowledge, dedication, and creativity. Our student-to-faculty ratio of 6:1 provides individualized attention and fosters a passion for learning. It is vital to our school and our students that we retain our superb faculty, have the ability to recruit other top educators, and compensate them fairly. Therefore, one of the most critical long-term investments that Marin Horizon needs to make is in faculty compensation.

In 2021, we ranked sixth among eight comparable independent schools in the Bay Area in average and median faculty salaries. We must do better to ensure that their income steadily grows

toward the 75th percentile of other independent school salaries so that we can remain competitive and provide our teachers with the compensation they deserve.

We have set a goal of \$3 million to establish a Board-designated endowment fund focused on faculty retention. Income from this endowment will allow us to attract and retain outstanding and valued faculty, who are at the heart of Marin Horizon School.



Our Marin Horizon community is a generous one. From volunteering for projects, to supporting our students, to record-setting annual fundraising and support for key initiatives, our community steadfastly responds to current and emerging needs with guidance, counsel, and generous resources.

The Next Horizon Campaign will make great strides toward ensuring Marin Horizon School's current and future success as a vibrant educational institution. Our community is once again the key to realizing this important effort. We invite parents, alumni, friends, and foundations to join us as champions and advocates as we kick off this ambitious campaign.
