Created 10minute Qualtrics survey




Conducted recruitment through outreach to child care providers and community organizations



Analyzed responses from 75 participants




Barriers to Child Care

Seek promotion or more responsibility at work




Pursue additional education and/or training

Invest in support for low-income individuals






