

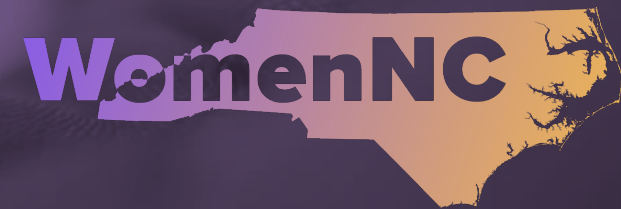

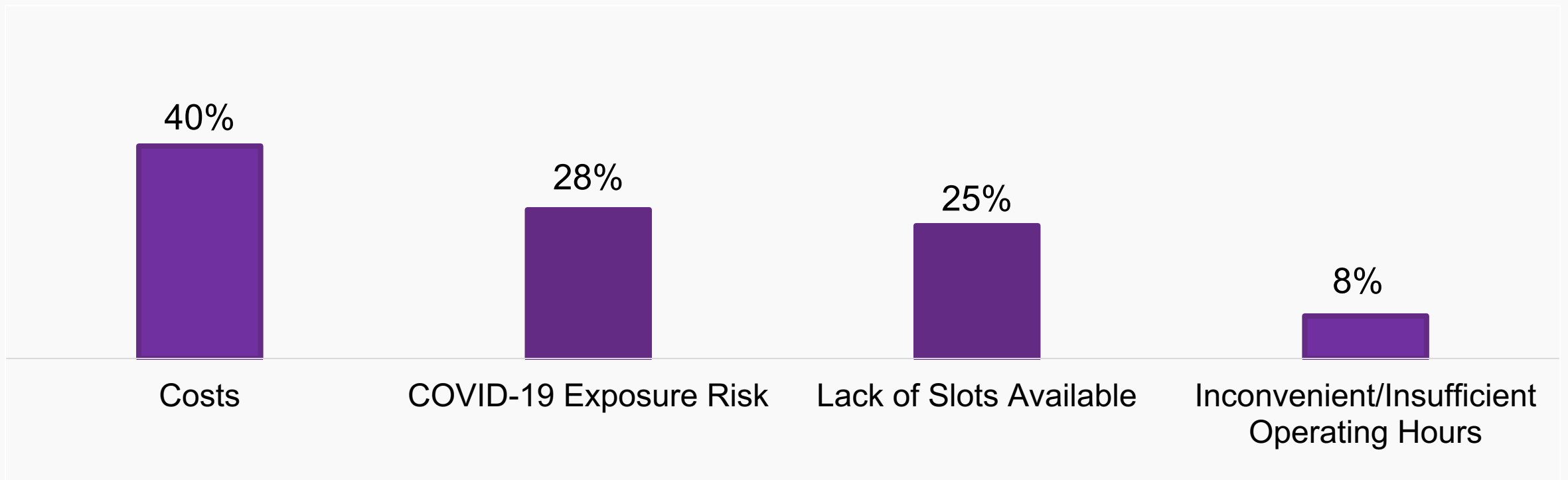

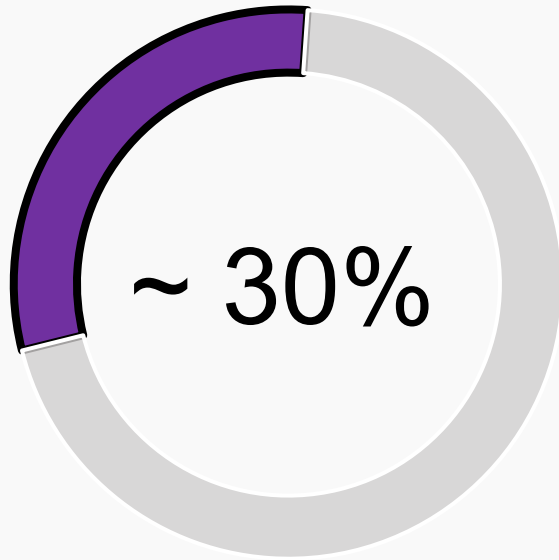

Look for a higher paying job



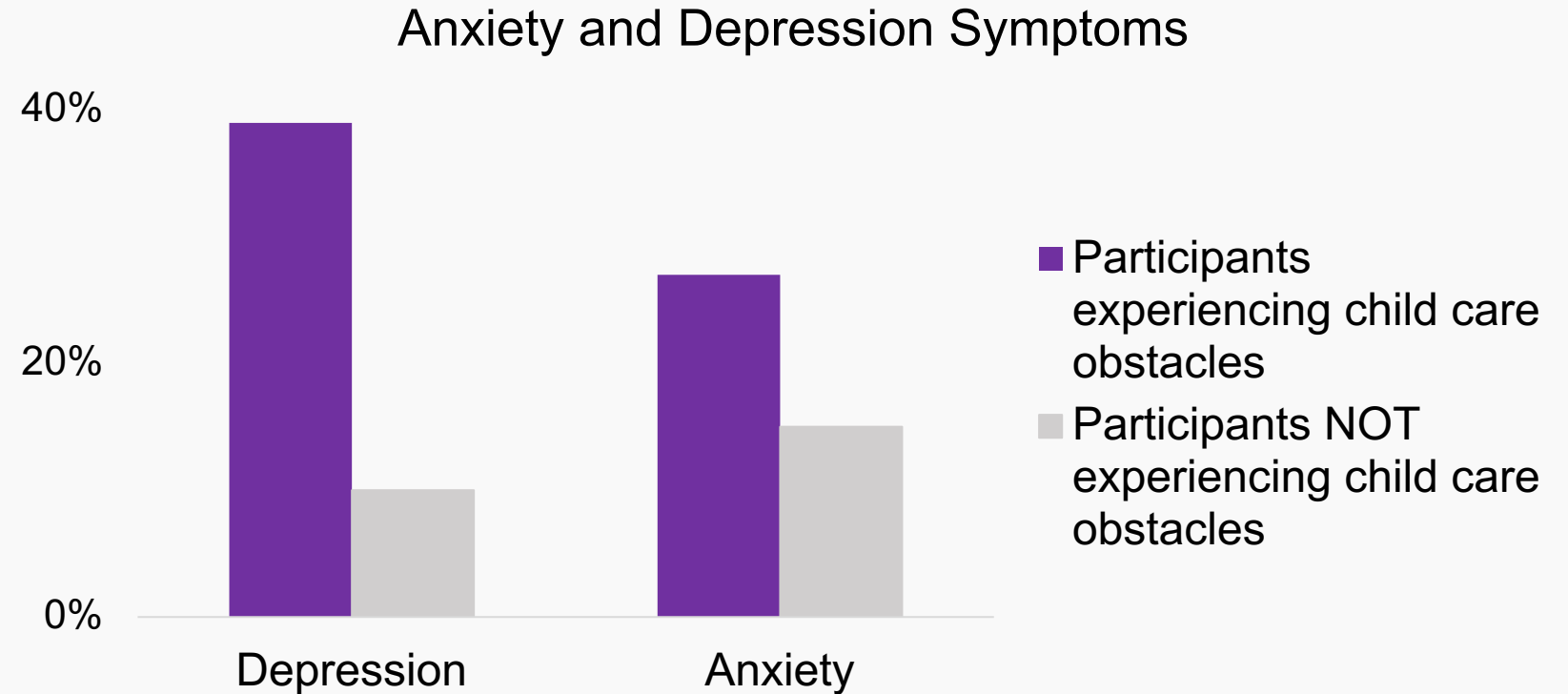
Seek promotion or more responsibility at work

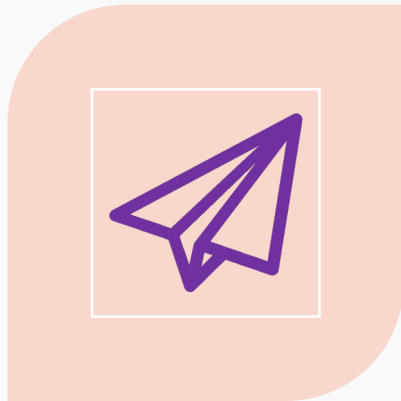
