SERMON NOTES



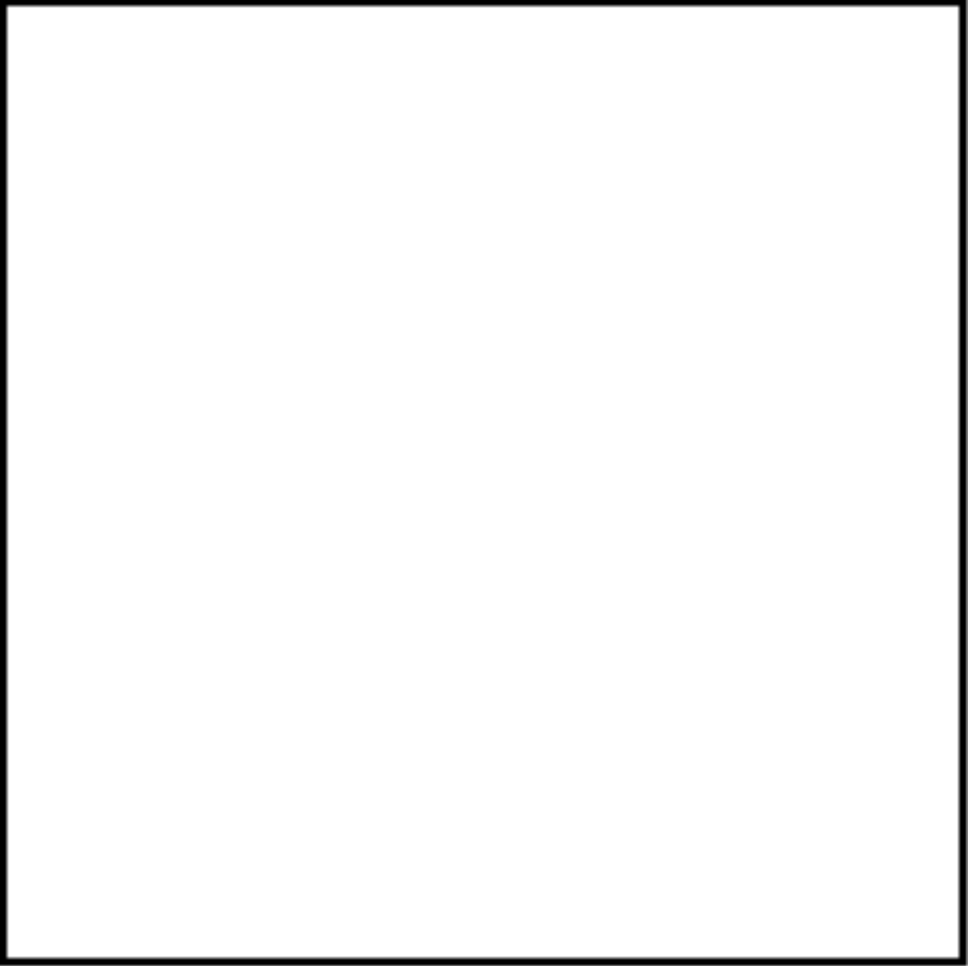
Usually we think suffering is only bad. But the Apostle Paul says that his suffering was super hard but he says it was also good. Did you know that God sends you suffering for your own good? That doesn't sound good but it's like this: -When a butterfly is coming out of its cocoon it has to struggle and work for hours to force its way out of the cocoon but all that struggling and squeezing pushes fluid from its body into its wings (like pumping air in a tire) and that makes its wings grow and spread. If you helped the moth out of the cocoon by cutting the cocoon for the moth its wings would never grow and it would die. But if you let it struggle and suffer it'll grow and it'll fly.

That's what our suffering is like. If you believe in Jesus, the good news is you don't ever suffer because of your sins. Jesus suffered for your sins on the cross and he saved you and God only ever loves you now. And God uses our suffering to grow us stronger. And Jesus is with you in your suffering, he is going to always get you through your suffering.

And you won't always suffer. In heaven there is no suffering. When Jesus comes back he'll make everything sad untrue and end all suffering. But right now God doesn't want you to think of this life like a big comfy couch. He wants you to think of it like a gymnasium and he's right there with you.
