SERMON NOTES



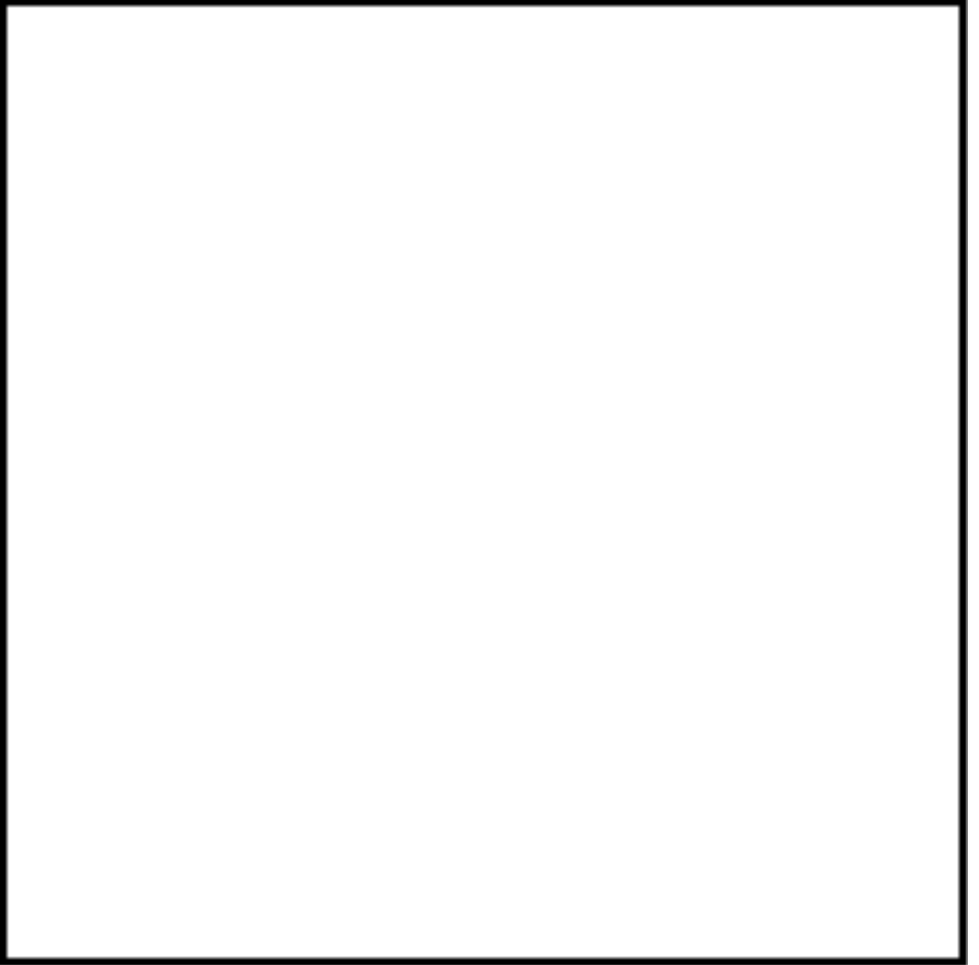
