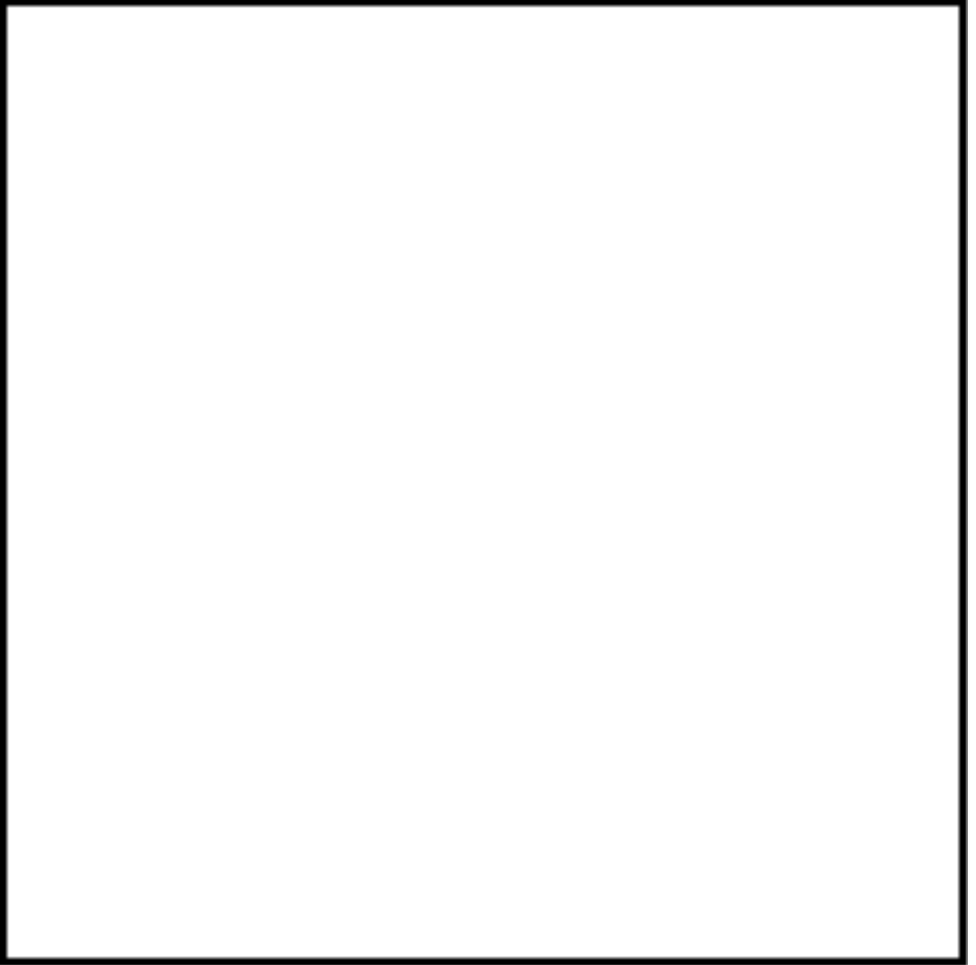
SERMON NOTES
