## SERMON NOTES



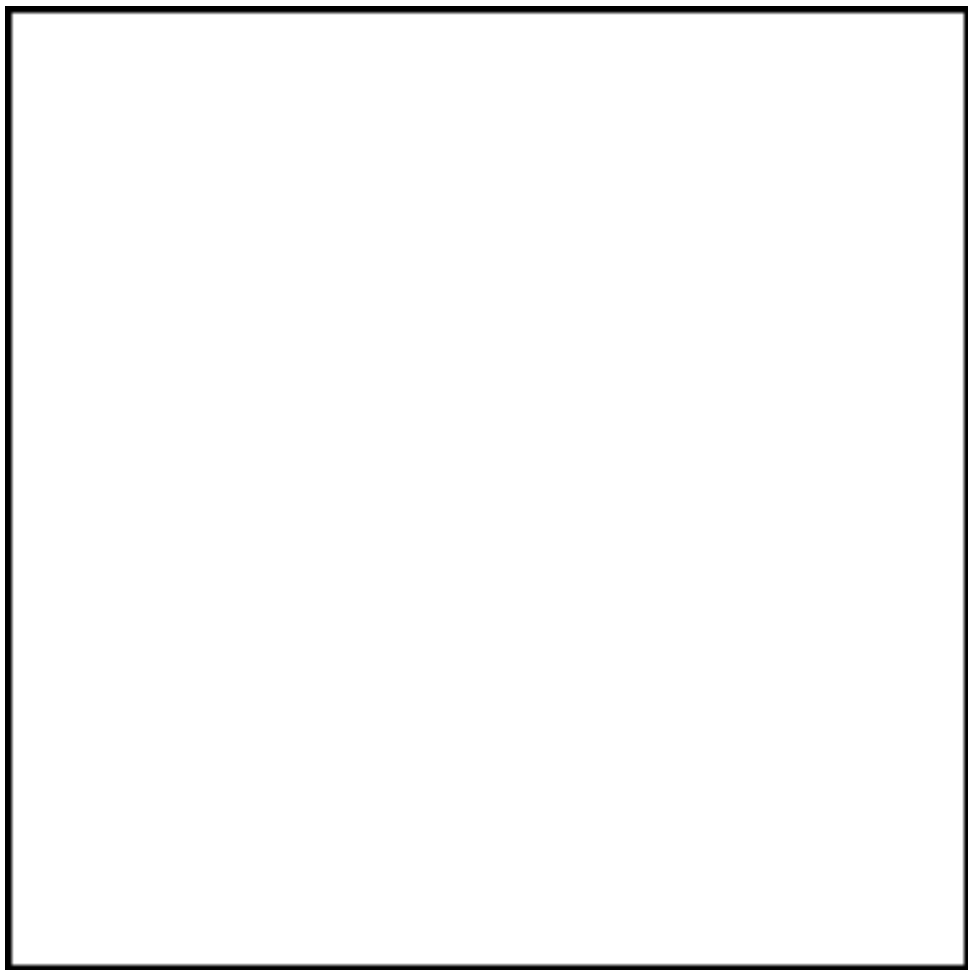
Kids, do you ever feel like your parents are holding out on you? Like there's something you need, something really good that would make your life really good AND your parents won't get you that thing; they won't let you have that thing; they won't help you with that thing?

What do you need that your parents are not giving you? Like getting you a new video game, or new phone, or new dog, or like doing your homework for you, or like giving you a break and NOT making you go to practice?

Hmmm, sometimes we can feel like God is holding out on us too. Back in the day there were some people in the church at Corinth who thought God was holding out on them. They wanted success and money and a good life and they thought God should give that stuff to them. And at the end of his second letter to the Corinthian church, 2 Corinthians, the apostle Paul tells this church that God has actually blessed them with everything that really need for this life. What they deserve is judgement for their sin. But, because God LOVES them he sent his Son, Jesus Christ, to take their judgment and die for their sin to save them. Not because they deserve it, but all out of his GRACE. And now they can know God's love and grace in this life and they will live forever with God in heavenly paradise and have FELLOWSHIP with him forever.
