SERMON NOTES



In Romans 7 the apostle Paul is talking about how a Christian relates to the Law like the Ten Commandments. Paul says in Romans 7:18-19, "I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out. 19 For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing." Paul does not mean the Law is bad. He means the Law shows God's people what is good and bad but the Law cannot make God's people good!

It's like the story of Frog and Toad Together. Toad bakes a ton of cookies and takes them over to Frog's. And they start eating cookie after cookie. They realize they got to stop or they're going to be sick but they can't stop eating one more cookie. Frog said, "We need willpower." "What is willpower?" asked Toad. "Willpower is trying hard not to do something you really want to do," said Frog. "You mean like trying hard not to eat all these cookies?" asked Toad. "Right," said Frog. So they put the cookies away in a box but they realized they could just open the box. So they tried a string around the box. Then they put the cookies high up on a shelf. But they realized they could still get the cookies. So they took the cookies outside and threw them to the birds. "Now we have no more cookies to eat," said Toad sadly. "Yes," said Frog, "but we have lots and lots of willpower." "You may keep it all, Frog," said Toad. "I am going home now to bake a cake."

That's what Paul is saying! The Law does not save God's people from their sin. AND, the Law does not have the power to change God's people and make them more holy once we're saved! You cannot change and be more holy just by willpower, just by trying really hard to be good. Paul tried and it almost drove him nuts.

The good news of the gospel is that Jesus saves us by following the Law for us. We are saved by grace through faith in Jesus. And, we are also sanctified, we are changed by grace through faith in Jesus. So trust in Jesus today and that his Holy Spirit lives in you helping you to love Jesus more and more and changing you more and more to look like him." The way to change is simply through faith in Jesus.
