## HOW WILL YOU INSPIRE CHANGE BEYOND YOUR LIFETIME?

---

After taking care of your loved ones, you can make your mark on the world by leaving a gift in your will (a bequest) to Free To Shine. This will help to ensure a safer and more equitable world for women and girls for generations to come, and it's easier than you might think.

We suggest seeking the advice of a solicitor when making your Will as they can help you make sure your Will reflects your intentions. They may talk to you about the following options:

### **Residual gift:**

This gift is the remainder of your estate or percentage thereof after your loved ones have been provided for and expenses have been deducted. This is the type of gift we usually recommend because inflation doesn't erode the value of your bequest and it allows you to take care of your family first, while maximising the impact you can create for your global family.

### **Percentage gift:**

This gift is used if you wish to divide your estate among a number of people or organisations. Leaving your gift as a percentage rather than a fixed amount also ensures that inflation doesn't erode the value and impact of your gift over time.

# SUGGESTED WORDING TO USE IN YOUR WILL

To make things easy, we've provided some wording that you can share with your solicitor.

I give, devise and bequeath, free of all duties or taxes...

5. **We will** treat your gift with sensitivity and respect.

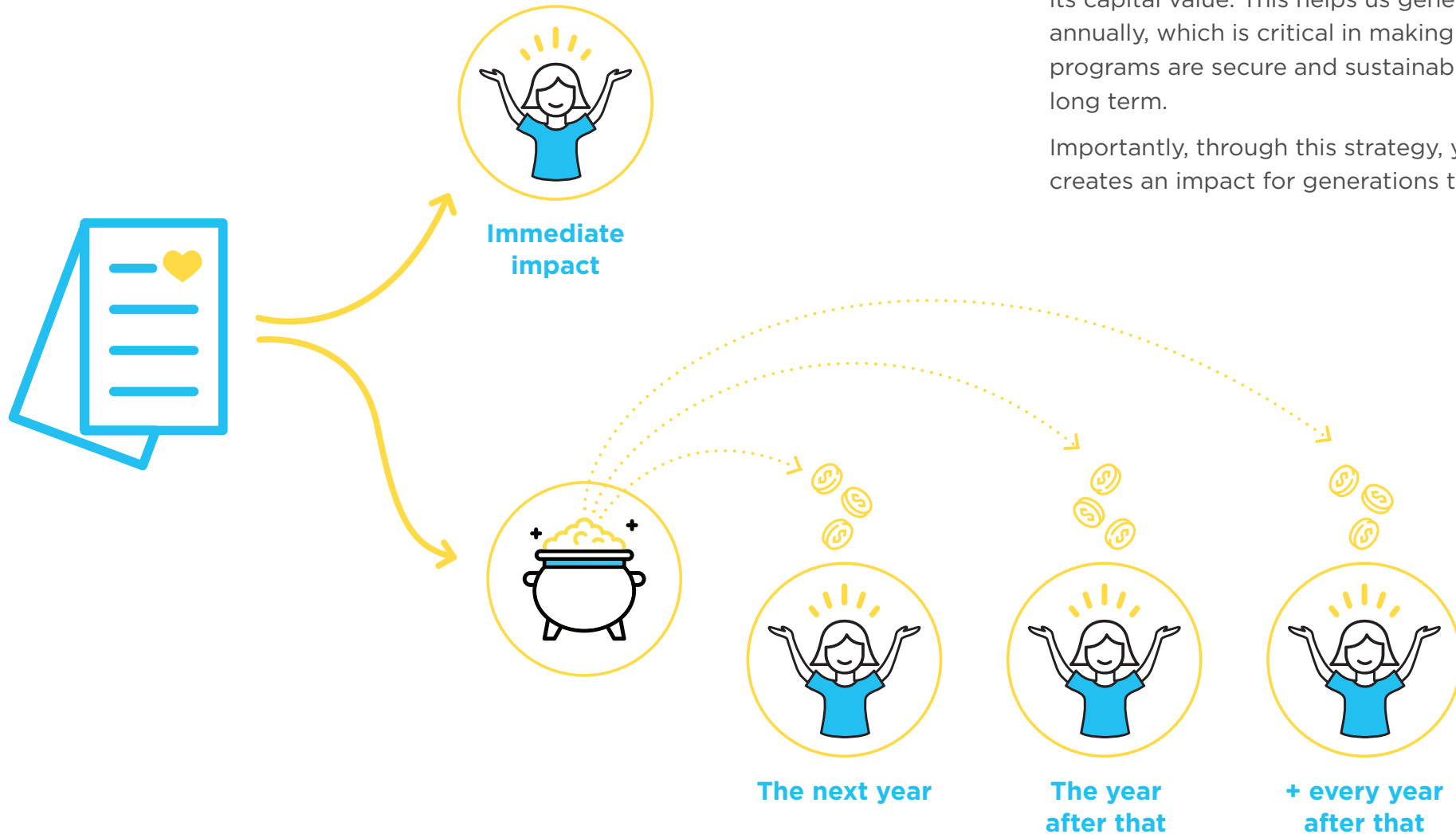
## We spend money well.

We get about on little motorbikes. Because we refuse to have inefficiencies, our money goes a long way.



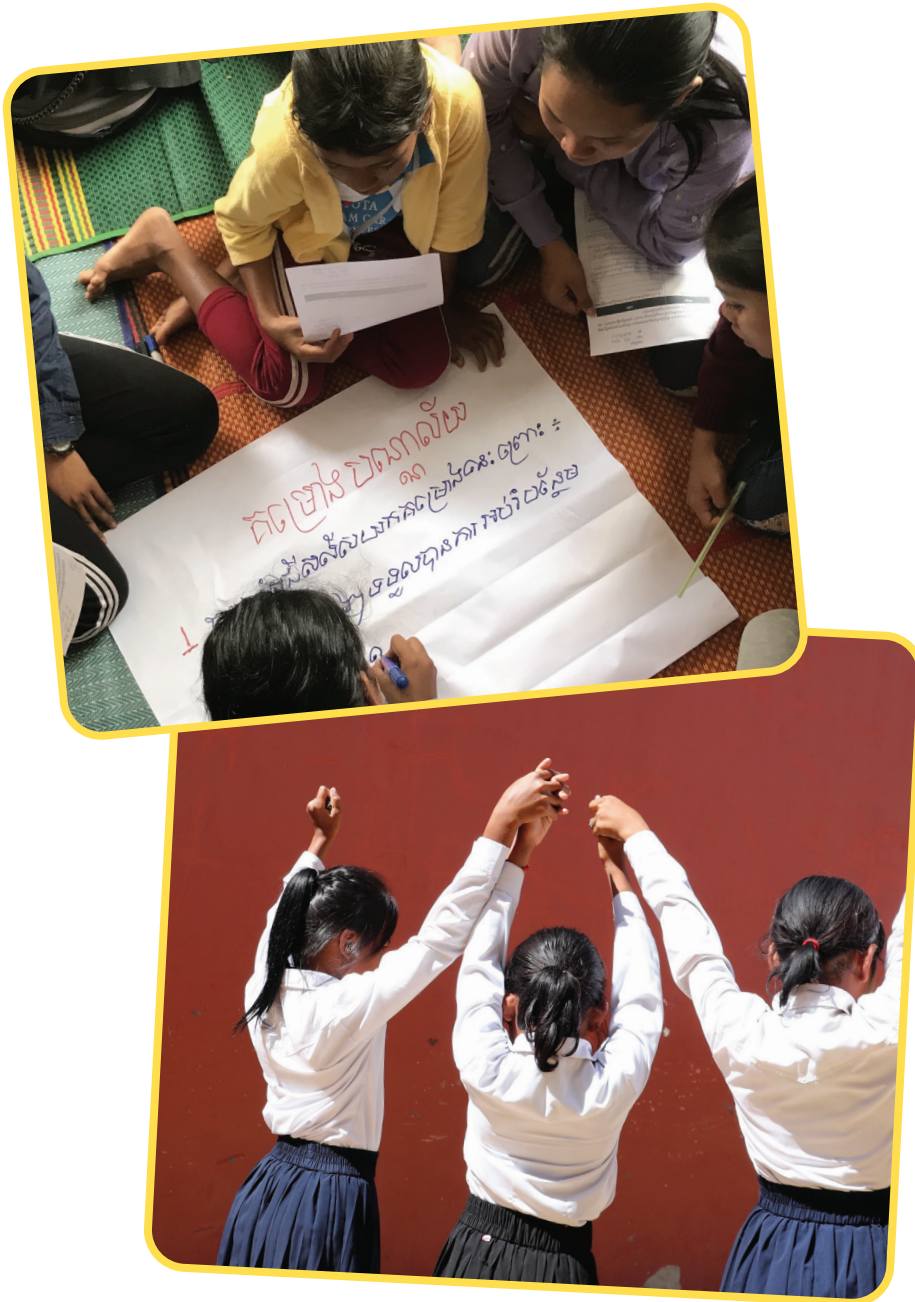
# HERE'S HOW FREE TO SHINE INVEST BEQUEST GIFTS



When a bequest is received, some of the funds are expended straight away, having an immediate impact on girls, their families and community.

A percentage of your bequest will be invested in a fund that is specifically set up to maintain its capital value. This helps us generate income annually, which is critical in making sure our programs are secure and sustainable over the long term.

Importantly, through this strategy, your gift creates an impact for generations to come.



## EMPOWERING THE NEXT GENERATION OF LEADERS

At Free To Shine, girls aren't given charity, they're given a team. And despite the challenges they face, so many of the girls on our program are eager to share their knowledge and improve their communities. For example, Ry\* is 14. She believes if she works hard, she can achieve her goal of being a teacher.

Ry was concerned that her community had nowhere to come together in the evening to read and learn. The nearest place was so far away that it meant children would be cycling busy and dangerous roads home, in the dark. Ry asked us if she could borrow a few more library books, and a white board and some markers to start her own small library at her house, and begin tutoring in Khmer and Maths.

Seeing her strength and determination we invited Ry to join our Emerging Leaders program. Her plan grew from a few books and a whiteboard to actually building a library and community centre. Ry's mum also uses the community centre to teach adults not to be violent to their families, and Ry's dad teaches Sanskrit. He envisions the library as a key part of turning his village into a "role model for other villages."

Ry lives in extreme poverty, facing challenges none of us have to, and she has an ambition that is exciting and makes her feel proud.

# THE FUTURE WE WILL CREATE TOGETHER

We've successfully secured the safety of more than 760 girls in the Siem Reap province. Once we enrol the other girls at risk in this province, and secure it from traffickers, we'll replicate our program in the next province, and the next, and the next.

**We have an exit plan; secure the safety of each girl at high risk of being targeted by sex traffickers, help her and her family achieve their basic human rights, and develop girl's leadership skills. In this way, in time, Free To Shine will be able to exit Cambodia knowing that the future of the country, and the safety of each future child, is in their capable hands. They'll be equipped with the skills and knowledge they need to ensure the safety, education, rights and opportunity of all children. We can then focus our attention on the second and third country.**

We have developed a model that works and we provide an opportunity for people to engage in a strategic partnership that changes the world, in a reliable way, using a system that works, and is scalable. We have made it possible, easy and rewarding for people to leverage the skills and knowledge they've acquired to make a meaningful, effective and practical contribution to something that really matters.
