- Spiritual Exchange program with a local church congregation.
- Curfew at 10:30 PM

A day of cultural exchange by visiting the OLD SAN JUAN city, one of the most beautiful places in Puerto Rico.

- Breakfast at Lodging location
- Devotional
- Departure to the Old San Juan city
- Lunch on your own in Plaza Las Americas
- Return to the lodging location
- Light dinner
- Curfew at 10:30 PM
