## How do I exhibit at Trainfest as a Model Railroad or Display Exhibitor?

We are easy to work with. There are two ways to apply, either complete the online application at www.train-fest.com or complete the application below and e-mail or mail it back to us.

On the application you will describe you layout and anything you need to exhibit. A letter indicating the status of this application will be sent after the application is received. The letter will state whether the application has been accepted, declined, or is on-hold (pending) while we complete the show floor plan. If placed in a "pending" status, you will receive an accepted or declined notice of this contact at least 1 month before the show.

Whether you are accepted or not depends on:

- The amount of space we have available
- The uniqueness your Model Railroad or Display
- How attractive your display is to the public
- Whether you will permit attendees to operate trains on your model railroad

For layouts and displays that are accepted approximately 1 month before the show you will receive detailed information about your location on the floor plan, exhibitor badges, shipping, and other details about exhibiting.

We urge you to complete your application as soon as possible. The amount of Model Railroad and Display space is limited.

## What is different from previous Trainfests?

The show is being held at the Baird Center (Formerly, The Wisconsin Center) for the first time in many years. Last year's event was 145,000 square feet, and with the move we will have 170,000 square feet! The Baird Center also allows the option of public transportation for guests and has easily accessible hotels.

While the dates remain similar to previous Trainfests, it is sliding back a couple of weeks due to the presidential election. Advertising will be severely impacted in early November, so moving the show back a couple of weeks will solve that issue. The floor plan will be new with the venue change, but will follow the same priority as the 2022 event. Space will be assigned in the following priority: Manufacturers, Retailers, Operating Model Railroads, Non-Operating Displays, and nonprofit organizations.
