

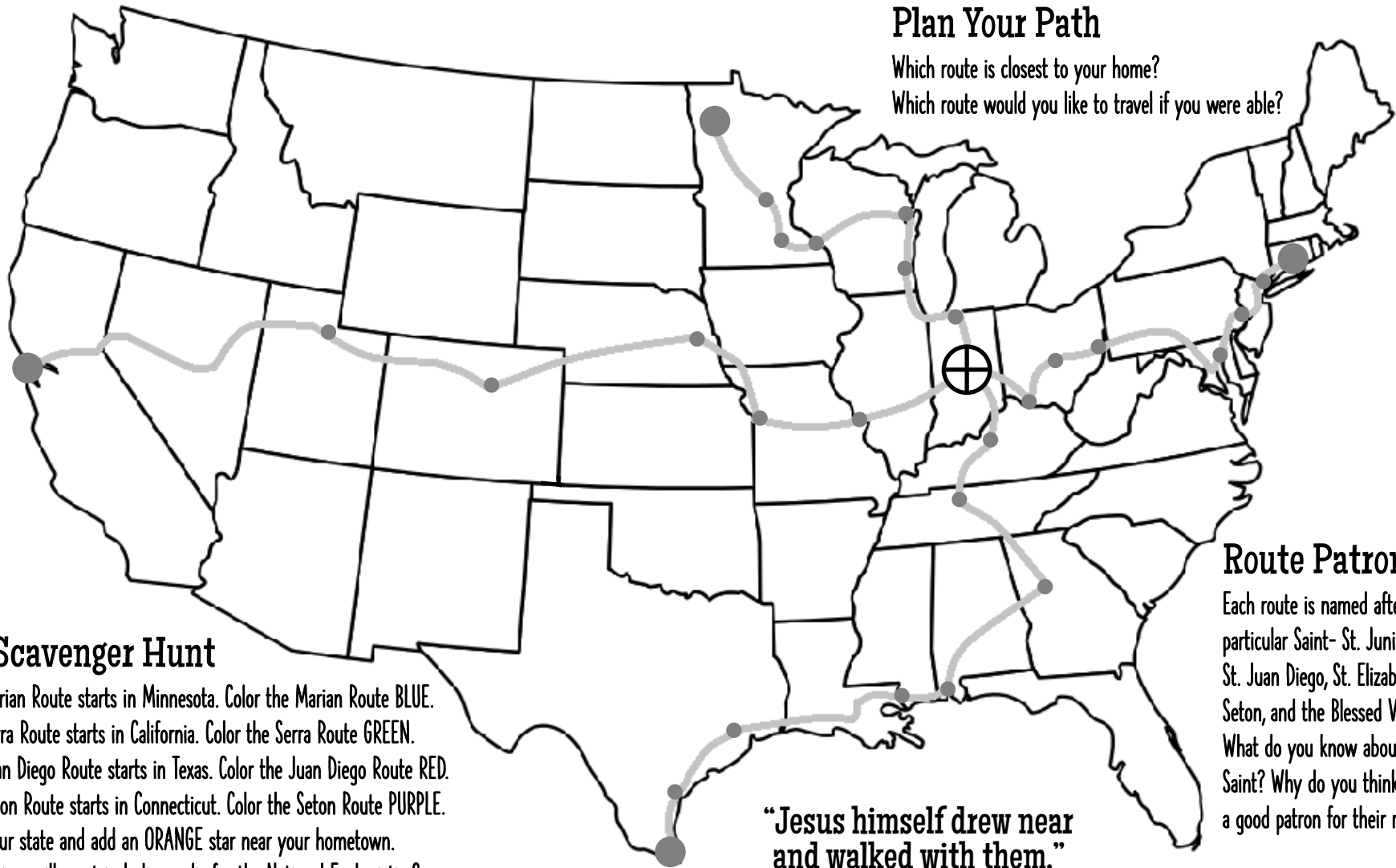
National Eucharistic Pilgrimage Map

- The Seton Route starts in Connecticut. Color the Seton Route PURPLE.
- Find your state and add an ORANGE star near your hometown.
- All pilgrims will meet in Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress. Circle the Monstrance in Indiana with YELLOW.
