

#### **BREAKOUTS**

- Each afternoon will host two rounds of breakouts that are focused on equipping participants to become Eucharistic Missionaries
- A wide range of topics will be covered, such as "Synodality and the Eucharist" and "The Bible and the Eucharist"
- The two rounds intentionally overlap to allow time for processing, prayer, and rest







#### AFTERNOON EXPERIENCES

- Each afternoon, our exhibit hall will be open where you can meet vendors, apostolates, and ministries from around the country
- We will also have the National Shroud of Turin Exhibit and other similar opportunities to learn and experience more of our faith
- There will also be spaced dedicated for prayer, including designated locations to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation or attend Perpetual Adoration



#### REVIVAL EVENING SESSIONS

- All Congress attendees will gather together in Lucas Oil Stadium for a powerful general session where we will experience the revival Our Lord desires to accomplish

#### MEDIA CREDENTIALS

- If you are planning to attend the NEC as a representative of the media, you must apply for a press pass to be approved for media credentials
- To apply, you can access the form under "MORE RESOURCES" on the Registration page: https://www.eucharisticcongress.org/register
- Media credentials include:
  - Media badge with photo
  - Access to "Press Only" areas throughout all NEC venues
  - Access to the media lounge staffed by security daily Reserved desk space with outlets in the media lounge

  - Ability to reserve meeting space and post-production space adjacent to the media lounge
- Additional details:
  - Organizations can apply for up to four press passes under one application Badges will be available upon check-in at the media lounge

  - Credentialed media will be grouped into four different levels of access that will determine which "Press Only" areas can be accessed. These determinations will be made and communicated directly this spring.
- \*Please note that a press pass does not equal registration. Even if credentialed as media, you must still register for the event to be included in the overall headcount. Instructions for how to register for the event will be provided to you after your application for credentials has been reviewed.



#### MEDIA LOUNGE

- Credentialed media will have 7am -- 11pm daily access to the secure Media Lounge at the Crowne Plaza -- the closest connected hotel to the Convention Center and Lucas Oil Stadium
- Media Lounge will include:
  - Reserved desk space to file stories and leave equipment
  - Access to free internet
  - Snacks and beverages
  - Lounge seating
  - Space for meetings (limited and by reservation only)
  - Post-production space (limited and by reservation only)



#### HOTEL BLOCK FOR MEDIA

- A limited number of rooms have been set aside for independent media that are not affiliated with a diocese or media sponsor
- To apply for a room in the media hotel block:
  - Apply for a press credential
  - Once approved, register for the NEC
  - Once registered, contact Kate Sell or Carrie Kline with your room request
  - Room requests are not guaranteed and are granted in the order in which they are received until the block is full
  - Media can request up to two rooms
  - Additional rooms can be requested for the Wait List and will be offered in the event of cancellations



#### HOUSING

- There is still affordable housing within a 20-minute drive of LOS/ICC, including near the airport, to be found on the <u>Visit Indy site</u>
- We have partnered with CTS and JMJ to offer assistance to those looking to bring groups to the Congress
- We also have alternative housing options and encourage individuals to seek housing options such as VBRO and Airbnb
